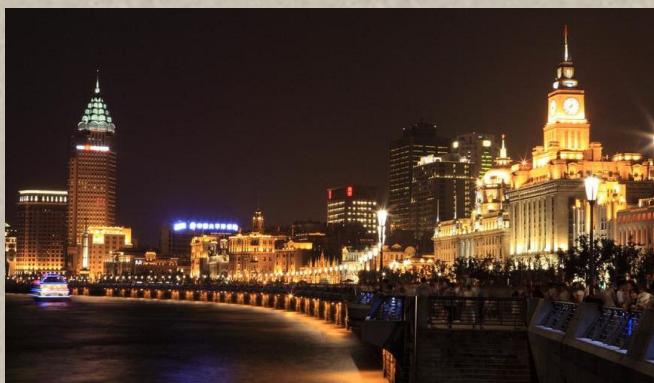




Introduction of Shanghai University
